Welcome to the City of Truro Rifle Club.

Our members aged from 12 to 75+ will be able to talk to you about the skills and challenges of target shooting - a sport enjoyed by male and female alike.

The Club has the <u>strongest coaching team in the County</u>, with more than a dozen qualified County and Club Coaches and Club Instructors.

The Club has all the equipment you will need, and makes no charge for its use.

The City of Truro Rifle Club is one of the foremost Clubs in the Country and provides more than half of the County Team. Club members compete in the British Championships at Bisley, each year, and over the years have had many successes.

The subscriptions per annum are: Under 18 and full time students £25.00. 18 and over £50.00.

New members will serve a trial period of 6 months, and will pay half subs for that time. They will then be eligible to become full members and will pay a proportion of the other half.

A Range Fee of 50p for Juniors and £1.50 for Seniors (over 18 years) is charged for each evenings shooting.

.22 Ammunition is priced from £3.50 per 50 rounds, which would normally be enough for two evenings. Ammunition is stored in the Club Armoury at the end of each evenings shoot, and must not be taken from the range unless you are able to enter it on your firearms certificate.
