Information Sheet No. 2 Health and Safety Information

The City of Truro Rifle Club prides itself on its safety record, and has a few simple rules which we insist are adhered to.

Range Safety Rules.

Always wear ear defenders during shooting.

Never point a gun at anything you do not intend to shoot.

Keep your finger off the trigger until your sights are on the target.

Always obey the Range Officers commands.

No rifle or pistol is to be loaded except on the firing point, with the muzzle pointing downrange. Wait for the Range Officer's instruction to start, and stop with the instruction 'Cease Fire'.

At all times except when firing, the rifle breech must be open and breech safety flags must be in place, and whenever possible, the rifle placed in the rifle racks.

No-one may go forward of the firing line without the range officer's instruction.

In the event of a mechanical failure or a miss-fire, stay on the firing point with the rifle pointing down the range, and ask the Range Officer for assistance.

After you have completed your shooting, ensure you wash your hands.
