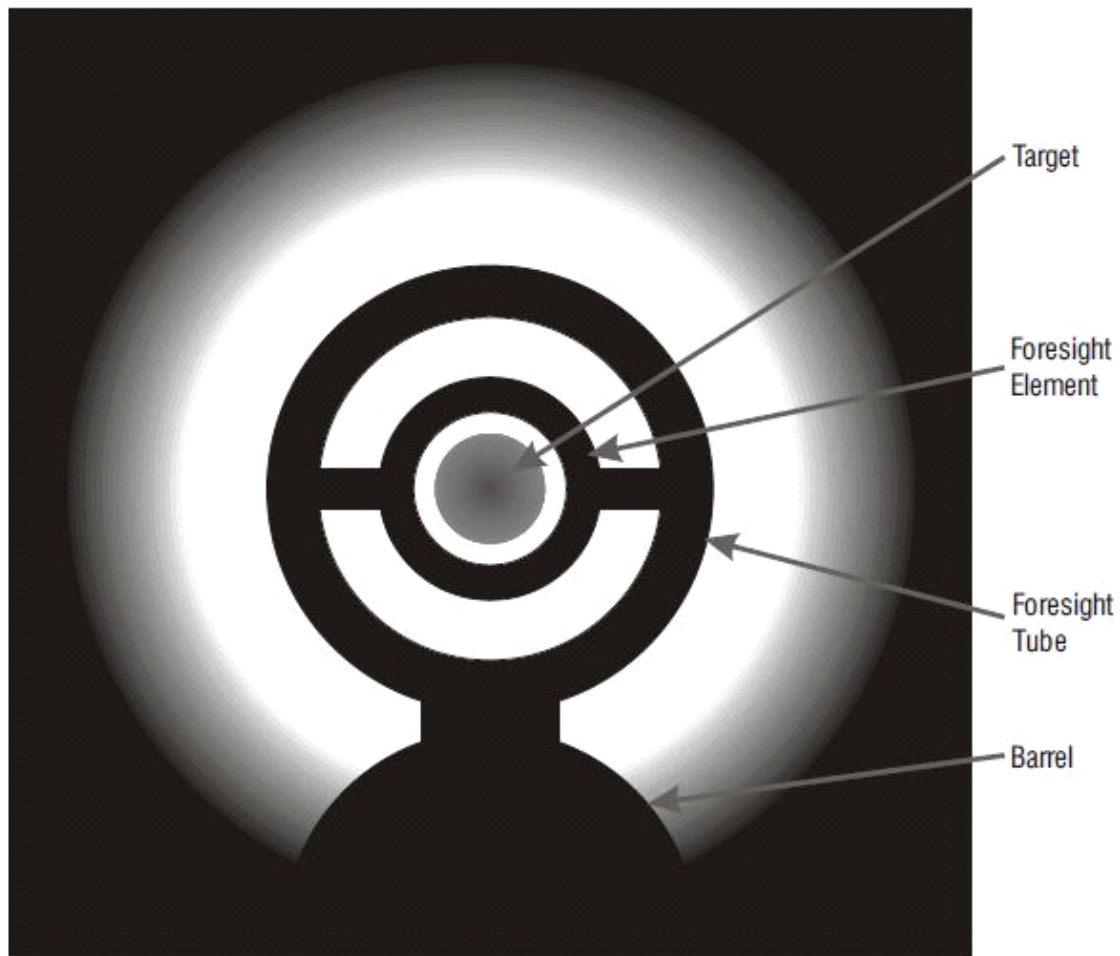

Information Sheet No. 4 How to Aim the rifle



The above picture shows the ideal aiming image the shooter should see through the rear sight aperture

Firstly the shooter's eye must be positioned to look centrally through the rear sight.
Then line up the foresight in the centre of the rear sight.
Now align the target in the centre of the foresight to give the picture shown above.
The image of target may not be sharp—but it needs to be in the centre of the foresight

An expert shooter makes the following checks while aiming and firing the shot.

- Check: Position**
- Breath control**
- Concentration**
- Relaxation**
- Centre the rearsight**
- Centre the foresight and target**
- Trigger release**
- Follow through**
